Here's what I tell her:

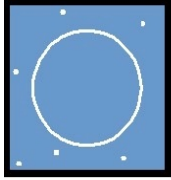
The traveller asks me if I have a message for her, any wisdom or insight that she might find helpful over the next 29 days as I wax and wane in the skies above her.
